The updated Seaford Community Centre will include a full service library, Council customer service, an improved meeting room and updated toilets.

Residents will also be able to access free Wi-Fi and public computers.

Council's Customer Service Centre will relocate from 120 Nepean Highway in Seaford.

Access and parking

During the works, there may be changes to parking in the area. Please check local signage for updates.

Groups with existing bookings for the main hall will have access during construction. No new bookings can be made for during the construction period.

The meeting room and kitchen at the front of the hall will be unavailable.

Works will start Monday 17 August with completion and re-opening scheduled for this coming summer.

There will be an increase in noise levels at times. Council will work with businesses and the community to minimise inconvenience and work after-hours as much as possible.
