The Frankston City Open Space Strategy will guide the future planning, provision, design and management of public open space for the next 20 years. The strategy provides the strategic vision, framework, outcomes and priorities that support Council's commitment to creating liveable, sustainable and well planned communities for the future.

## Purpose

The Draft Frankston City Open Space Strategy 2015–2035 provides a strategic framework for decisions and allocations of resources to ensure:

- A complete and legible open space network that delivers health and wellbeing, social, environmental and economic benefits for the Frankston City community
- A diversity of open spaces that are easily accessible, adequately provisioned, safe, meet with the expectations of the community and are a joy to use

The strategy identifies opportunities and challenges to address the open space needs of the existing community and forecast population within the municipality. The strategy also provides an integrated open space framework to support the justification for a fair and equitable open space contributions program.

Incorporated into the strategy are a range of recommendations for Council and the community,

including open space projects and other actions to be undertaken through to 2035.
