Population and growth of our state

Victoria is the fastest growing state in the nation, and 90% of that growth settles in Greater Melbourne. Melbourne is home to 77% of all Victorians. Victoria is projected to grow to 10 Million people by 2050, and on the current trend, Greater Melbourne's population will be around 8 million.

This level of centralized growth is unsustainable.

The Victorian Leader of the Opposition the Hon Matthew Guy, MP announced a Population Policy Taskforce to consider how population may be re-balanced around the state, and identify opportunities to share economic growth so that no Victorian is left behind.

The Forum is part of an extensive community consultation about how the state can manage this unprecedented population growth.
