Construction update

- Piling works at Seaford Road are complete
- Substructure works have now commenced
- Works are also underway on the southern embankment
- Utility relocation works are continuing

Upcoming works:

- U-trough beams will be lifted into place in August
- Embankment works will continue
- Utility relocations will continue
- Frankston Freeway work zone to be established





Disruptions:

- Throughout July, there will continue to be changes to traffic conditions as a consequence of utilities works
- Traffic management will be in place.

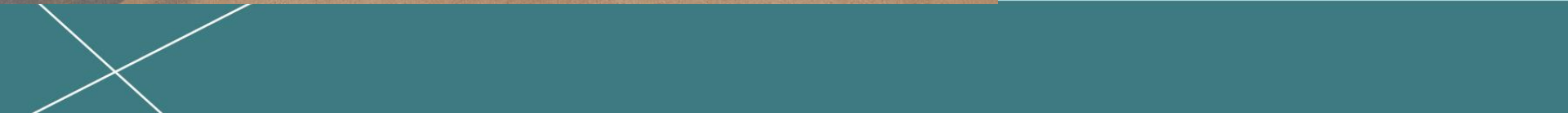

What we've heard

- Final stage of the Seaford revitalisation community consultation has closed

Key areas of interest:

- 6kms of new walking and cycling paths
