Works alert – Seaford Level Crossing Removal

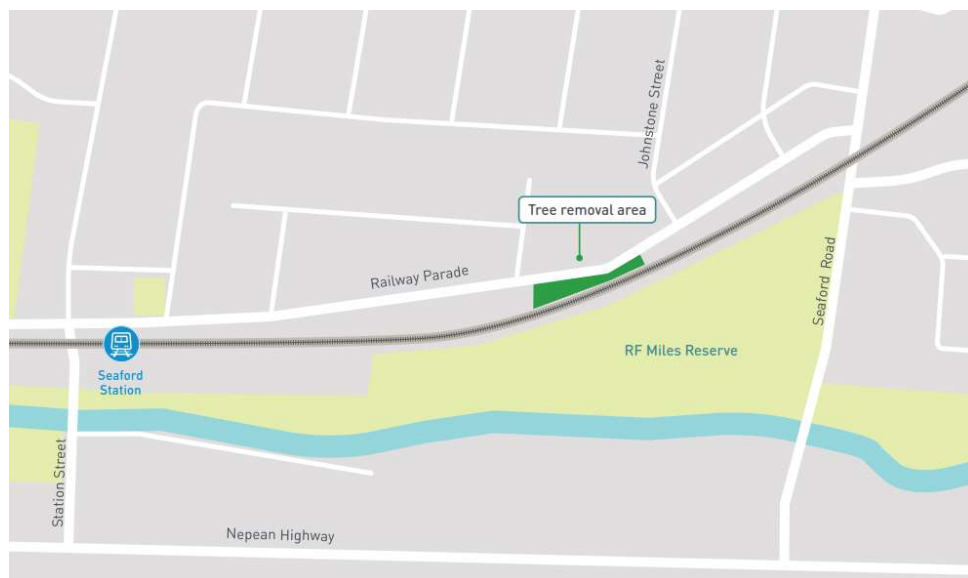
The Victorian Government is removing 13 dangerous level crossings on the Frankston line, and building a new train storage facility to improve safety, reduce congestion and run more trains, more often.

Works are well underway for the removal of the level crossing on Seaford Road. We are continuing to construct the embankments and bridge foundations for the new rail line, as well as relocate utility services ahead of the major construction blitz starting mid-August to remove the level crossing.

Activities taking place

Approximately 10 trees need to be removed on Railway Parade, between Johnstone Street and Myra Street, adjacent to the rail line. This is to allow the construction team to undertake essential works on underground utility services that run along the rail alignment. These activities will take place from Thursday 23 August for up to a week.

What to expect

- Prior to removal, trees will be inspected for the presence of wildlife, with qualified wildlife handlers on call to safely relocate wildlife, if required;
- Trees will be removed using chainsaws and other standard equipment including an excavator, stump grinder and mulcher;
- Trees will be mulched on site to allow for easy and safe removal;

How this will affect you

- Noise from equipment may be noticeable
- There will be additional vehicle movements in and around the area
- Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of road users and our workers

The Level Crossing Removal Authority works with arborists, as well as environmental and sustainability specialists, across all its projects to minimise the amount of vegetation removal required, and to manage the impacts on flora and fauna.
