Works alert – Vegetation removal


The Victorian Government is removing 13 dangerous level crossings on the Frankston line, and building a new train storage facility to improve safety, reduce congestion and run more trains, more often.

As part of our work to remove the level crossing at Seaford Road the existing combined services route will need to be relocated. This will be located within the rail corridor, however, to undertake this work some trees and vegetation need to be removed.

Activities taking place

Between Eel Race Road and Seaford station approximately 10 trees will need to be removed, and approximately 100 other trees and shrubs need to be trimmed. This is to allow the construction team to relocate underground services that run along the rail alignment. These activities will commence on Saturday 1 September 2018.

What to expect

- Prior to removal, trees will be inspected for the presence of wildlife, with qualified wildlife handlers on call to safely relocate wildlife, if required;
- Trees will be removed using chainsaws and other standard equipment including an excavator, stump grinder and mulcher;
- Trees will be mulched on site to allow for easy and safe removal;

How this will affect you

- Noise from equipment may be noticeable
- There will be additional vehicle movements in and around the area
- Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of road users and our workers

The Level Crossing Removal Authority works with arborists, as well as environmental and sustainability specialists, across all its projects to minimise the amount of vegetation removal required, and to manage the impacts on flora and fauna.
